This Cookie Policy (hereinafter referred to as "Policy") sets forth the terms and conditions for the use of cookies, contains all essential provisions, and serves as a public offer for Users.

By accessing or using the Website, or accessing its materials and services, the User agrees to the terms of this Policy and accepts it.

Definitions

Website	A collection of information, texts, graphics, designs, images, audio, video materials, and other protected intellectual property elements and tools of individualization owned by the Administration, including software contained in an information system providing access to such information on the Internet, including the domain and subdomains at https://whoisguilty.com
Website Administration	individual entrepreneur Aleksandr Soldatov, Personal Data Operator, and Website owner
User	An individual (Internet user) who uses the Website
Cookies	Small fragments of User data sent by the server and stored by the Administration to authenticate the User, save their preferences, and collect statistics
NS (Name Server) records	DNS records that define which servers are responsible for handling queries for a particular domain

1. General Provisions

- 1.1. This Policy defines the cookie usage terms of individual entrepreneur Aleksandr Soldatov, located at 51 Shpalernaya St., Office 601, St. Petersburg, 191015, Russia.
- 1.2. The Website utilizes CloudFlare servers for global content delivery and protection. As such, cookie data may be processed in jurisdictions where CloudFlare servers are located, including but not limited to the United States. The User acknowledges and

agrees to the transfer of their data to such jurisdictions as per the provisions of this Policy.

- 1.3. By accessing or using the Website and its materials and services, the User consents to the use of cookies by the Administration, including cookies that are not strictly necessary for the functioning of the Website, upon User's explicit consent.
- 1.4. Depending on the User's browser settings, the Administration collects information automatically transmitted by the browser when the User visits the Website.
- 1.5. Information collected includes:
 - IP address of the User's device.
 - Operating system type and web browser,
 - Preferred language and User location.

2. Cookie

2.1. Cookies – small text fragments sent by a server to the User's device (computer, smartphone, etc.) and stored in the User's browser.

2.2. Types of Cookies We Use:

(a) Essential Cookies

Required for the Website's basic functionality, such as navigation and access to requested services.

(b) Performance Cookies

Gather data on Website usage to improve navigation, usability, and security.

- 2.3. Persistent cookies may include:
 - 2.3.1. **Analytics Cookies:** Track User activity on the Website (e.g., pages visited).
 - 2.3.2. **Preference Cookies:** Remember User preferences, such as language or location.
 - 2.3.3. **Mandatory Cookies:** Ensure uninterrupted operation of the Website.
 - 2.3.4. **Third-Party Cookies:** Codes from domains outside the Website for additional functionality.
- 2.4. **Cookie Retention Period:** Cookies are stored on the User's device for as long as necessary to fulfill their intended purpose or until the User deletes them. The retention period varies depending on the type of cookie (*par. 8.1. 8.2.*).

3. Purpose of Cookies

- 3.1. To ensure proper Website operation, collect session information, create statistics (e.g., visitor counts), and analyze User interaction for optimization.
- 3.2. To improve content quality and functionality.

3.3. Some cookies are created by third-party analytics or advertising services.

4. Data Processing

- 4.1. Cookies are processed using Yandex.Metrica:
 - Details available at Yandex.Metrica
 - Operated by Yandex LLC, located at 16 L'va Tolstogo St., Moscow, 119021, Russia.
- 4.2. The Website also uses CloudFlare services, and cookies may be processed on CloudFlare servers, ensuring enhanced security and performance. The User consents to the transfer of their data to the United States or other countries where CloudFlare operates, as described in this Policy.
- 4.3. Legal Basis for Data Processing: The legal basis for processing personal data via cookies is the User's consent, given upon visiting the Website or adjusting browser settings.
- 4.4. Cookies are processed exclusively using CloudFlare services. CloudFlare's servers handle DNS and website security, ensuring enhanced performance and protection for the Website.
- 4.5. Cookies and related data may be processed on CloudFlare servers located in the United States or other jurisdictions where CloudFlare operates. The User acknowledges and consents to the potential transfer of their data to these locations in accordance with this Policy.
- 4.6. The processing of cookies and related data is based on the User's explicit consent, provided upon visiting the Website or by adjusting their browser settings.
- 4.7. Cookies processed through CloudFlare are used for:
 - Improving website performance through caching and content delivery optimization.
 - Protecting against DDoS attacks and other security threats.
 - Providing analytics on website usage to enhance user experience.

5. User Rights

- 5.1. In accordance with GDPR, Users have the right to:
 - Access their personal data collected via cookies.
 - Correct or update their personal data.
 - Delete their personal data.
 - Restrict or object to the processing of their data.

Withdraw consent at any time, which will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

- 6.2. Periodic changes to this Policy may occur. Users are encouraged to review this page regularly. Any changes to this Policy will be effective upon posting on the Website.

7. Domain Configuration

8. Retention Period for Cookies

- 8.1. Cookies used on the Website are stored for varying periods, depending on their type and purpose:
 - **Session Cookies**: These cookies are temporary and are deleted automatically when the User closes their browser. They are used to maintain the functionality of the Website during a single browsing session.
 - **Persistent Cookies**: These cookies remain on the User's device until they expire or are manually deleted by the User. The retention period for persistent cookies is set to a maximum of **12 months** unless otherwise specified.
- 8.2. Users can manually delete cookies stored on their devices at any time through their browser settings.
